Registration: 8:00 – 9:00 AM; 1st Round begins promptly at **9:30 AM**. If you attempt to register after 9 AM then you will incur a zero point bye for round one and then paired for Round 2. If you have registered in advance, then you will be paired automatically for Round 1.

Rounds & Time Control: 6 Rounds; 30 minutes per player, also known as Game 30. Rounds 1 and 2 will be GM/20. Rounds will start directly following the completion of the previous round. All players will play all six games. If you need to leave early or arrive late, please notify the tournament director.

Byes: You may request as many byes as needed however you may only have one ½ point. Any additional byes will be zero point byes. You must also request these byes before the first round starts.

Entry Fee: \$10 received by Thursday, October 29 online.

Onsite Registration: Entry Fee: \$20. Home schooled players are always welcome.
