Notes:

- Be advised there are grade and skill levels for section placement. Be careful
- Tournament Director reserves the right to re-format sections based on attendance
- You may have to play your own teammates; however we will try to avoid that for as long as possible
- Siblings will not have to play each other
- Home school teams welcome
- Team trophies will be based on the top 4 individual scores from each team per event. You need at least 2 players to qualify as a team per event.
- Individual awards are per section
- Team awards are cross-sectional. For example, let's say you have 4 kids in the novice section; 2 in the K only and 2 in the 1-3 U 300. They are all from the same school. We will take the top scores from both sections and make a composite.
- If you have an established rating through www.mychessrating.com we will use that. If you don't then we will use either your Kansas scholastic rating or your USCF rating (whichever is higher). If you have no idea what I'm talking about that means you are unrated.
- Time control will not be time delay. Time control will be sudden death.
- Please review Scholastic Tournament Rules prior to play. It is your responsibility!

Rounds: 4 rounds; rounds will start directly following the completion of the previous round.

Byes: only one ½ point; must notify in advance of tournament.

Entry Fee: \$17 received by Friday, September 30 online.
No onsite registration

Advanced ceremony will start at roughly 3:30 pm
